



Double Row Bracelet

Item #B005



Materials:

16 size 8 seed beads (clear, in this example)

210 size 11 seed beads (maroon colored, in this example)

This is for an approximately 6-3/4" bracelet. For each extra 3/8" desired, add:

1 more size 8 seed bead, and

14 more size 11 seed beads

1 clasp

bead thread or wire

Instructions:

You can work this bracelet without pre-cutting your thread. Keep the thread on the spool and just unwind as you need to, sliding the beads down the thread. This should prevent you from losing all your beads off the end of the thread too!

String 1 of the large size beads (size 8) onto your thread. Then string 7 of the small beads (size 11) onto the thread. Repeat this pattern (1 large, 7 small) until you have 15 segments, or as many segments as you need for your desired length. End by stringing one more large bead onto the thread.

Now string one part of your clasp onto the thread (see Figure 1a), and then go back through the last-added large bead (see Figure 1b). Add 7 small beads and then pass the thread back through next-to-last-added large bead. Continue in this pattern, adding 7 small beads and then passing the thread back through the next large bead, creating a double row, joined together at each large bead.

When you go back through the very first large bead, string the thread through the other half of the clasp. Now you can

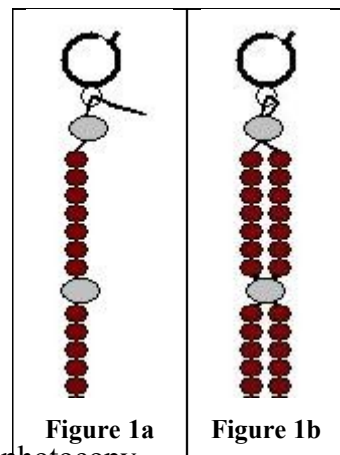

tie off your thread with the beginning thread, leaving an inch or so of thread beyond the knot to weave back into the beads. Cut off any extra thread.
